The gut microbial ecosystem is essential for normal nutritional, physiological, and immunological functions of the animal. Disturbance in the microbial ecosystem creates an opportunity for pathogenic organisms to colonise and cause disease. Increased understanding of the important role of the microbiome in the gut health can be applied to manipulate microbiome and to improve health and productivity. The process governing the settlement and the maintenance of a balanced intestinal microbiota is a subject of many research projects, focussed on nutritional requirements of the microbiome, microbe-phenotype relationships, precision nutrition under different physiological and metabolic conditions and during poor health to better harness the power of the microbiome to develop new strategies for livestock production systems.
